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1. **SWOT Analysis** (By Subash Krishnan, Coaching and Development Specialist)

Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats (SWOT) is an effective tool for job seekers to prepare for a job interview. By conducting a personal SWOT analysis, you can identify your competitive edge and present yourself more effectively during an interview.

trengths

- Think about what you do exceptionally well that is relevant to the job. This might include technical skills, soft skills, experiences, certifications, or personal attributes.
- Consider your past successes and how they might be of interest to the potential employer. Have examples ready that showcase how your strengths have contributed to positive outcomes in previous roles.
- Are you particularly resilient, adaptable, or creative?
 Think about positive personal characteristics that give you a competitive advantage.
- Acknowledge any gaps in your skills or experience that are relevant to the job but be ready to discuss how you are taking steps to address them.
- Focus on weaknesses that are not critical to the job description. Present them in a way that shows your proactive attitude toward growth and learning.
- When discussing weaknesses, frame them as areas of development rather than insurmountable flaws.

Opportunities

- Research the industry and the company to identify current trends. Demonstrating awareness of these trends, and how your skills align with them, can show that you are forward-thinking and a potential asset.
- If you have connections that could be advantageous to the company, or if you come with a strong professional network, this could be an opportunity worth mentioning.
- If you are engaged in any continuous learning or professional development that relates to the job, mention how this could benefit your potential employer.
- Address the competition indirectly by emphasizing what makes you unique compared to other candidates
- If there are known challenges in the industry, be prepared to discuss how you might navigate them effectively, using your strengths.
- Be mindful of personal circumstances that could impact your job performance and have strategies ready to manage them.

Remember SWOT analysis is best done in reference to the job description and the organizational needs. If you can, do a SWOT analysis of the organization and compare it with your own personal SWOT analysis. You will be able to see clearly where your strengths can assist the business' weaknesses and how you can turn around the threats of the organisation into opportunities.
